Re: Construction Logistics and Community Safety - Australia (CLOCS-A) Memorandum of Understanding Confirmation as a Supporting Partner

I am delighted to confirm that Bicycle NSW is proud to apply to the join the CLOCS-A Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) [Finalised Version dated \[3/2/2021\]](#) as a Supporting Partner (SP).

The MoU records the agreement between the Steering Group Partners (the Parties) and the SPs to form a relationship to work together in improving road safety and the operational efficiency relating to the logistics of the construction of infrastructure projects. The MoU will act as a catalyst for CLOCS-A Parties and SPs to champion and guide the establishment of CLOCS-A.

Bicycle NSW as the peak advocacy body for bike riders has consistently campaigned for safer construction, heavy vehicles and traffic management in NSW to improve the safety of bike riders. We have developed content related to [heavy vehicle safety improvementⁱ](#), [safe construction managementⁱⁱ](#), and have advocated with MP's and government staff for legislative change. In the face of poor road safety education to support bike riders, we developed our own [#Safety on Spokes campaignⁱⁱⁱ](#), supported by Suez Waste Management and launched at NSW Parliament House with broad political support.

As a SP of CLOCS-A, we commit to support and champion the introduction of CLOCS-A in NSW and Australia more broadly. For us this can't come soon enough. The construction boom in NSW has seen greater numbers of heavy vehicle movements and too many bike rider deaths.
